

The project «European citizenship us unifying identity» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project involved 94 citizens, notably 30 participants from the city of Rimóc (**Hungary**), 33 participants from the city of Rosice (**Czech Republic**), 31 participants from the city of Strenči (**Latvia**).

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Rimóc (Hungary), from 01/08/2019 to 04/08/2019.

Short description:

The day of **01/08/2019** was dedicated to project participants can get to know each other in an informal atmosphere and learn more about project programme.

The day of **02/08/2019** was dedicated to project activity – conference "The Impact of European Union Policy on Everyday Life". Conference took place in Dr. Manga János Community Center. Conference was opened by János Beszkid - chairman of Rimóc municipality. During the conference Malva Šķēle - manager of Europe Direct Information Center in Valmiera - introduced participants with the topic. Project partners worked in groups and presented their future ideas which could be implemented in municipalities and how could European Union help to do that. After the conference happened excursion in Rimóc.

The day of **03/08/2019** was dedicated to project participants and local residents could introduce each other with their intangible cultural heritage. At Rimoc village day participated not only local singers, dancers and artists but also guests from Latvia and Czech Republic. Latvia was represented by Strenči dance group "Tīne" and musicians trio who performed Latvian popular music. Czech Republic was represented by Rosice knight association "Taranis" and women's choir "Rosalky". In the first half of the day project participants visited Hollókő village that is included in UNESCO world heritage list.

The day of **04/08/2019** was dedicated to project participants could visit Mátraverebély-Szentkút Franciscan priory and to participate in Mass. In project closing achieved results were discussed.
